While they were talking, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, **“Peace be with you.”** They were startled and terrified, and thought that they were seeing a ghost. Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things.”
