

Then will He say also to them on His left hand: Go from Me, ye accursed, into everlasting fire,

which was prepared for the Calumniator and his angels.

For I was hungry, and ye gave Me no food; and I was thirsty, and ye gave Me no drink; and I was a stranger, and ye took Me not in; and I was naked, and ye clothed Me not; and I was sick or in prison, and ye did not visit Me.

Then will they also answer and say: *Our Lord*, when saw we Thee hungry, or thirsty, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and we did not minister to Thee? Then will He answer, and say to them:

Amen, I say to you, That inasmuch as ye did not so to one of these little ones, ye did not so to Me.

And these will go into everlasting torment, and the righteous into everlasting life.




