#### Toòay's Gospel<sup>1</sup> St. John 10: 22-42

It was the festival of the Dedication<sup>2</sup> in Jerusalem, and it was winter.

Jesus was walking in the Temple, in the porch of Solomon, and the Jews came around Him and were asking Him, "How long will You keep us in suspense? If You are the Messiah, tell us so plainly."

"I have told you," Jesus answered them, "and you do not believe.

The works that I do in My Father's Name testify to Me. Yet you do not believe, because you are not of My

sheep, as I have told you.

My sheep hear My voice. I know them, and they follow Me. I give them eternal life. They will never perish,

and no one can snatch them from out of My hands.

My Father, Who has given them to Me, is greater than all, and no one can snatch anything out of His hand. I and My Father are one.

Once again the Jews picked up stones to stone Him

Jesus said to them,

I have shown you many good works from My Father. For which of these do you stone Me?

The Jews said to Him, "It is not for good works that we stone You, but because you speak blasphemy, since You, being a man, make Yourself God."

Jesus said to them,

*Is it not written in your Law:* "I have said you are gods"?3 If He called them "gods", since the word of God was with them and Scripture cannot be nullified is it because I have told you, "I am God's Son" that you say to the One the Father has sanctified and has sent into the world, "You speak blasphemy!"? *Unless I am doing the works of My* Father, do not believe Me. But if I do do them, even if you do not believe Me, believe the works themselves, that you may know and believe that My Father is in Me and I in the Father.

And again they tried to seize Him, but He escaped from their hands.

Then He went across the Jordan, to a place where John had been before when he was baptizing, and He remained there.

Many people came to Him and were saying, "John did not perform even one sign, but everything John said about this man is true." And many believed in Him.

### **SUNDAY, RITE OF CATECHUMENATE:** St. John 3: 1-7

Now there was a man there, one of the Pharisees, whose name was Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews.

This man came to Jesus at night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know You are a teacher sent from God, for no one could do the signs You are doing unless God is with him."

Jesus answered him, "Amen, I say to you, unless a person is born again, they cannot see the kingdom of God."

"How can an old man be born?", Nicodemus asked Him.

"He cannot enter his mother's womb and be born a second time, can he?"

"Amen, I say to you", Jesus said in reply to him.

Unless a man is born of water and the Spirit
he cannot enter the Kingdom of God.
What is born of the flesh is flesh, and what is born of the Spirit is spirit.
Do not be surprised that I have told you, "you must all be born again".
The wind blows where it pleases and you hear its sound, but you do not know from where it comes or where it is going.
So it is with everyone born of the Spirit.

#### **ABOUNA'S REFLECTIONS**

This Sunday is the day that Alonzo (*Nemetallah*) and Lorenzo (*Steven*) Michaud enter formally on the path of the **catechumenate** and declare publicly their intention to be baptized at the Epiphany. We noted in September that there were three principal stages to the Baptismal Rites. In September, we witnessed ceremonies of **Naming**, the **Signing** with the Cross, and formal entrance into the church, which, as it were, was the moment that the Church took each of these young men under her wing and protection.

Today, we witness the **Exorcism**, **Renunciation** of Evil, and the **Profession of Faith** that each of us must profess and live out in order to enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

It is thus a solemn day, and we will replace the Liturgy of the Word from that of the Renewal of the Church with that taken from the Ceremonies of Baptism. You will find these texts in the blue booklets in the pews, beginning on **p. 10**. Note that the *Qadishat* will be sung according to that of the Epiphany on **p. 113** in the red missals.

As these young men are sixteen, their Baptism is considered one of adults and they will be fully Maronites, sons of Saint Maron, on the day of their full initiation in January.

As they take these steps toward becoming true sons of our holy father, *Mar Maroun*, we pray for them as today they take this significant step toward the Hidden Light, Who is the God of all consolation. *Barekhmor*, *aloho deelan!*
