

In the morning, on the first day of the week, after sunrise, they came to the tomb.

And they said among themselves, "Who will roll the stone away from the tomb entrance for us?" Then they looked and saw that the stone had been rolled away, for it was very large.

They went into the tomb and saw a young man sitting on the right side, wearing a white robe, and they were astonished.

But he said to them, "Do not be afraid. You are seeking Jesus the Nazarene, Who was crucified. He is risen; He is not here. Look – the place where He had been laid. But go tell His disciples and *Kepha*, 'See, He goes before you into Galilee. You shall see Him there, just as He has told you'."

When they had heard this, they fled from the tomb, for astonishment and trembling had seized them.

And they said nothing to anyone, because they were afraid.

ABOUNA'S REFLECTIONS

The Glorious Resurrection is not something done for our Lord, but *for us*, with the potential of something to be done *to us*. We contemplate this great mystery as it restores in us hope, individually, for what we

are each meant to be; and, collectively, it bedazzles our senses to consider what mankind was meant to have been from the beginning.

The human "person" is a truly mysterious thing. We can know someone for years and yet still be surprised at any moment by an action or a word they might do. While each of us is truly and fully human by nature, each of us is also truly, individually, and *indefinably* a human person. The two are not exactly the same. The "person" is that fullness of existence, the wholeness of subsistence, that make each who he is. In the case of our Lord, entirely and perfectly human in every sense except sin, the full, specific uniqueness of His individual humanity was possessed by the eternal Word. His ineffable 'person", and the entirety of His existence was the Ihidoyoh Bro - the Singular and Unique Eternal and Divine Word. This is why death could not hold Him in the grave and, as the Living One, death and sin were consumed in His divinity.

What took place on the morning of the Resurrection, thus, was not for our Lord personally – as the Hidden God, death and sin were aberrant to His Being and consumed in His Brilliance – it was done for us to reopen the return to the Garden, and to unveil the possibility of created life within the uncreated Triune God, face-to-Face in Vision. For all this gift, we bow down in awe and adoration before the Life-Giving Cross, and we ask strength to engage on the Living Path that has now been opened to us.

O Messiah, we have put on the new man created in Thy likeness and have been decorated with the jewel of glory, purchased with Thy Blood!³


