#### TOÓAY'S GOSDEL¹ St. Matthew 1: 18-25

The generation of Jesus the Messiah happened in this way:

When His Mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph – but before they had come together – she was found to be with child through the Holy Spirit. Now Joseph her husband was just and he did not wish to expose her to shame, so he thought to separate from her secretly.

While he pondered these things, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said to him, "Joseph, Son of David, do not fear to take in your wife Mary because what has been conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. She shall give birth to a Son, and you shall name Him *Yeshua'*, for He will save His People from their sins."

Now all this came about in order so that which had been spoken by the Lord through the prophet would be fulfilled:

Behold, the virgin shall be with child and she shall give birth to a son, and they shall call him Immanuel, which is interpreted, "with us is our God".<sup>2</sup>

When Joseph arose from his sleep, he did just as the angel of the Lord had commanded him, and he took her in as his wife.

But he did not know her 'til she gave birth to her Firstborn Son.

And she named Him Yeshua'.

## The Nativity Sast

December 15-23<sup>rd</sup> inclusively

As we were reminded by our Patriarch in his recent Lenten Letter, it is our tradition to fast in preparation for the great feasts, and all are encouraged to do so faithfully, *par*. 25:

This fast is known as "The Fast of the Nativity", during which the faithful abstain from eating meat, dairy products, and eggs, from **December 16**<sup>th</sup> and ends **December 24**<sup>th</sup>.

NB for the faithful in the USA, who celebrate Christmas Eve much as Christmas, the dates are 15<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> December inclusively.

We are reminded in *paragraph* 21 of the same letter that "a fast" is to go without all foods from midnight to noon, after which we abstain from all animal flesh and animal products – this is most similar to a "vegan" diet as one would call it these days.

When a fast day falls on a Saturday or a Sunday (as will be the case this year on December 15<sup>th</sup> and on December 21-22<sup>nd</sup>) one can eat as they wish throughout the day, but should still abstain from all animal flesh and animal products.

These observances are **for all who have attained the age of the use of reason**, *par*. 22.


